To conduct Placement activities and enhance the placement opportunities of the students	In 2024- 2025, out of 123 final year students, 107 students got placed and the placement cell has achieved 83% of placements. A total of 9 companies/ institutions including Sureti Insurance Marketing Pvt Ltd, Kongunadu Senior Sec.
